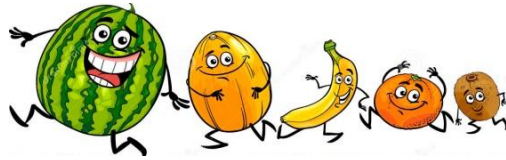




Boughton - Under - Blean News
