

As you know, we have been using our 'Good To Be Green' (G2BG) behaviour system since September. This has helped to promote positive behaviour through the ability to spend their behaviour vouchers at the G2BG Shop at the end of each term. The children earn their voucher by demonstrating positive behaviour throughout the day.

If a children demonstrates behaviour that we do not expect to see, they face consequences linked to the G2BG system (*please see our behaviour policy for a clear criteria of what type of behaviour results in which sanction*).

As we are always looking to develop the school further in any way we can, we have decided to introduce a system to work alongside what we already do.


If a child loses their behaviour voucher or receives a 'Warning' or 'Consequence' card, they will be given a slip to bring home to share with their parents. The slips will look like the examples below and will include information to explain why they have received it.

White' Warning (G2BG voucher lost)




