- Identify, understand and calculate **Prime Greenwich Meridian and Time zones** including day and night.

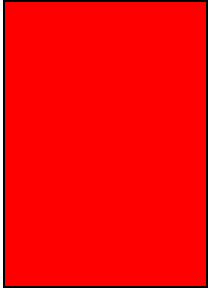
