

Level 1c:

- Identify the first sound (phoneme) in unfamiliar words.
- Pick out known words.
- Join in with familiar parts of a text.
- Use pictures to help.
- Discuss elements. they like and dislike.

Level 1b:

- Identify beginning and end sounds (phonemes) in unfamiliar words.
- Identifies and names full stops.
- Makes a simple prediction about what might happen next in a story.
- Identifies favourite part of a text.
- Sequences main events in a story.
- Identifies fiction and non-fiction texts.

Level 1a:

- Independently reads CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant, e.g. cat) words.
- Expects the text to make sense and tries to work out unknown words by using the other words in the sentence, or uses the context of the story.
- Retells main parts of story in correct order.
- Begins to relate what they read to their own experiences.
