Home Learning & Spellings

Inside each child's homework book there will be a homework sheet for the term, showing the homework choices for each week. The homework includes challenges linked to our work in school. Each week, each child may choose which challenge to do: a mild, medium or spicy one. Homework books will be due in school each Friday for marking and will be given out again each Monday.

In addition to this, spellings will be given out each Friday and tested on the following Friday. Reading books will be sent home for reading. These are changed every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Please remember to ask questions and discuss the stories with your child as decoding is not our only goal; comprehension and inference skills are also key to success. If a child reads at least five times a week, which is recorded in their contact book, they receive a monster sticker. If a child receives a sticker for each week of the term, they become a monster reader and is rewarded for this in school.

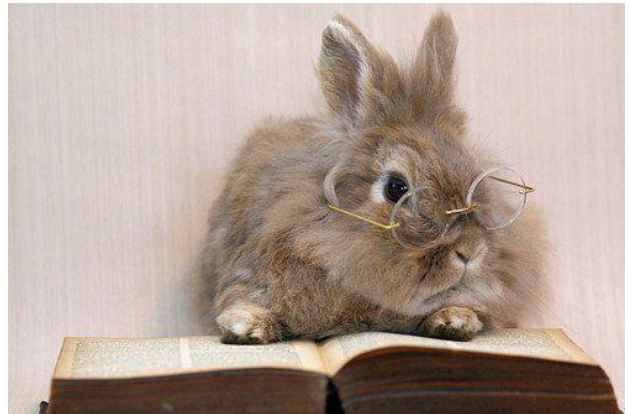
