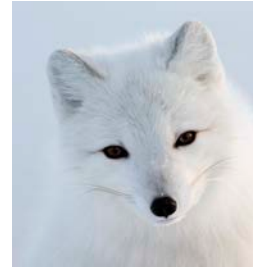


Arctic Foxes Newsletter

Independence

We are continuing to encourage your children to become independent young people giving them many opportunities to be responsible for their own learning. Please help us to strengthen these skills by encouraging your children to be independent in tasks at home and give them small responsibilities to under carry.

Presentation

We are very much encouraging the children to take a huge amount of pride in their learning. To support this we are working on our presentation skills. Term 2

Maths:

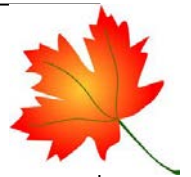
Counting, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, money, measures and time.
