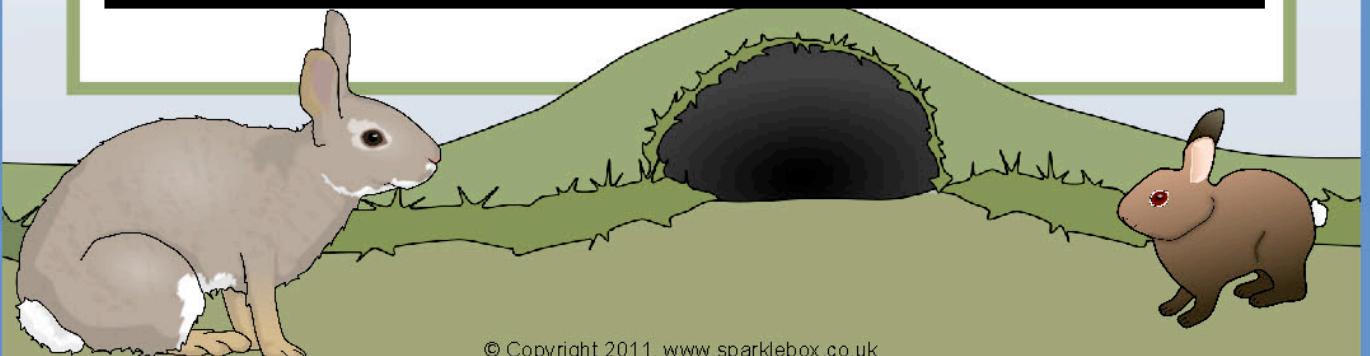
Home Learning
