

Term 6 Curriculum

English

This term we will begin by focussing on 'traditional tales' and have a particular focus on Red Riding Hood. Following this, the children will be looking at a variety of non-fiction texts and writing their own pieces including full stops, capital letters, adjective pairs, verbs and adverbs.

Maths

In Maths, the children will be focussing on number and calculating (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and revising our key areas before they head into year 2.

Science

In Science, the children will be carrying out a topic all about investigations. We will be thinking about our predictions, discussing ways to find answers to different problems and working on our close observation skills.

RE

In RE, the children will be having lots of class debates, discussing our key question, 'What makes a place sacred?' They will be looking into both Jewish and Christian sacred places and exploring their own thoughts and ideas as a group.

Art/DT

Within Art/DT, the pupils will be creating various pieces using different materials such as chalk, paint, pastels, clay and card.

Geography

The children will be carrying out a topic based on our local area and the place we live. This topic will be covering types of buildings, how to look after our environment, map work and finding out about the place we live and where this is located in the world.

Computing

In computing the children will be focussing on our key skills and also making short films using pictures taken.

PE

This term, in PE, year 1 will be continuing dance and playing team games with Mr Packer.
