## Home Learning & Spellings

Each Tuesday the rabbits will be expected to bring their homework book back into school for marking. On the Tuesday, they will also take part in a short spelling test on the words covered in their spelling homework.

Each week the rabbits will also be expected to read at least five times at home. A reading book will be provided for this activity. Each time the child reads, please log in their new reading log.

PE - Outdoor games and gymnastics.

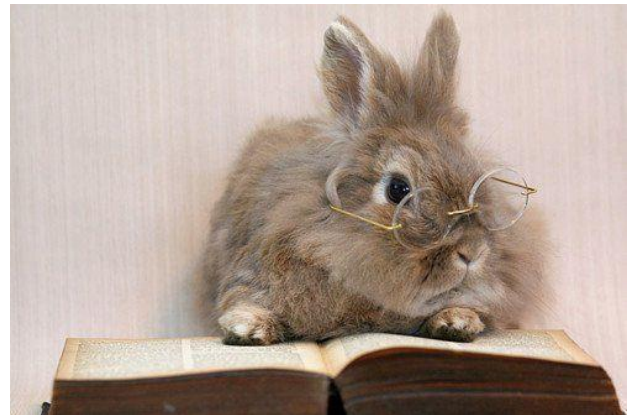
PSHE - New Beginnings. We will be discussing how we feel, our goals and targets for the year.
