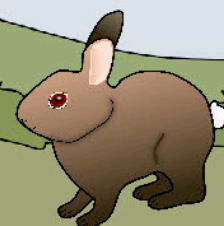
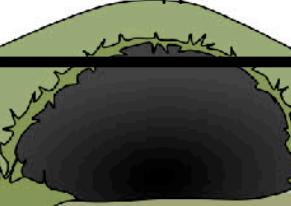
Home Learning
