Term 1

History

This term we are studying the Tudors. We will be learning about The War of the Roses, the Tudor monarchs and Henry VIII in more detail as well as their food, clothes and houses.

Literacy

In literacy we are exploring narratives. We will be reading some stories with historical settings linked with our Tudor topic and discussing setting and characterisation. The children will then write their own story with a historical setting.
