## Task 1 - Science

Complete an experiment of your choice (*this could be anything at all - look online for any ideas if you need*).

- Predict what you think will happen
- Draw a diagram of the experiment
- Write about your findings

## Task 2 - Maths

Collect some data and present it in a graph of your choice (*this could be a pie chart, a bar graph or a line graph*).

- Create the graph/chart (*remember to label axis etc*)
- Write about what your graph/chart shows
- Give up to 5 questions you could ask others about your graph/chart

## Task 3 - General

Cook or bake something of your choice.

- Collect and measure out ingredients
- Follow the instructions given
- Draw a picture or take a photo of your creation
- Write about how successful it was

## Task 4 - Writing

Write a piece of persuasive writing on a topic of your choice

## Task 5 - English

Learn a poem of by heart and perform it to others

Remember that all of these tasks are just suggestions to give you some guidance. Any tasks that you feel is helping your learning is still going to be really useful for you.

As I said before, feel free to use any workbooks you have already got or any you have borrowed from school, and don't forget about the websites you have been provided with before to help.
